### Event Schedule:

- **Friday, June 29:**  
Practice Day 3:00-7:00 PM (or as soon as the field is set up)
- **Saturday, June 30:**  
8:00-9:00 AM: Check-in  
8:00-8:45 AM: Official Practice  
9:00 AM: Shooting begins-70 meter round  
1:00 PM: (approx) Lunch  
2:00 PM: (approx) Shooting begins (team round)  
6:00 PM: (approx) Awards presentation
- **Sunday, July 1:**  
9:00-9:45 AM: Official Practice  
10:00 AM: Shooting begins (V formation, 60 arrows)

**Age:** Determined by age on January 1, 2012.

**Divisions: (archers can choose to shoot in an older division; contact the coordinators)**

**Bowman:** Up to and in year of their 12th birthday (born in or after 2000) (must be at least 8 years old)

**Cub:** Up to and in year of their 14th birthday (born in or after 1998)

**Cadet:** Up to and in year of their 17th birthday (born in or after 1995)

**Junior:** Up to and in year of their 20th birthday (born in or after 1992)

**Collegiate:** (full time college student)

**Senior:** Over 20 (born in or before 1992)

**Master:** Over 50 (born in or before 1962)

**Sr. Master:** Over 60 (born in or before 1952)

**Archery Rules and Notes:** Federation of International Target Archers (FITA) rules and regulations will be followed. This is a STAR FITA tournament where world and national records can be set.

Participants in FITA and Junior Olympic Archery Development (JOAD) divisions must adhere to the State Dress Code. No denim is allowed and shirts must be appropriate.

There are three separate events this year: 70 meter round, team round, and a V Formation. Details will be available on the Salt Lake Archery website.

**70 Meter round**

Cadets - 60 meters  
Cubs - 50 meters  
Bowman - 30 Meters

12 ends of 6 arrows  
minutes for each end  
122 cm target

**Team round**

Shot at 30 meters  
Tournament director puts together teams

**V Formation**

Targets are placed in a "V"  
Cubs and Bowman - 10, 15, 20, 25, 30, 30.25.20.15, 10 meters  
Cades and older - 20, 30, 40, 50, 60, 60.50.40.30, 20 meters  
Archers move along the shooting line from target to target  
6 arrows at each target; 4 minutes for each end  
122 cm targets

**SATURDAY EVENT**

Sr Master (60+), Master (50+)	60
Senior, Junior, College	70
Cadet	60
Cub	50
Bowman	30

All age groups will shoot at a 122 cm target.

TEAM ROUND: 30 meters; teams will be put together by the tournament committee.

**SUNDAY EVENT**

All divisions except cubs and bowmen will shoot at distances from 15 meters to 60 meters at a 122 cm target.

Cubs and bowmen will shoot at distances from 10 to 30 meters at a 122 cm target.
