



# Ultimate Frisbee

**Coordinator Rules:** These rules are only in effect during Friday pool play.

Hard Way: This is a fun rule taken from the lucky 7s tournament in Las Vegas; once per game a team can declare to the other team that they are going to try a Hard Way. The team pulling must acknowledge the hard way has been signaled. If the team then scores during that possession without a turnover they are awarded 2 points. However, if they score in that possession after a turnover has occurred 0 points are awarded.

Pull Points: During any pull if the disc knocks over one of the front cones marking the opposite end-zone they are awarded 1 point. Also during any pull if the disc knocks over one of the back cones marking the opposite end-zone they are awarded 2 points. The disc can roll into a cone knocking it over, and the receiving team are able to defend their cones, keeping in mind that if the pull is touched and then dropped before the disc hits the ground a turnover would result.

Remember these special coordinator rules are only in effect during Friday pool play

**Timeouts:** 1 timeout per half, no floater timeout, no time-outs in caps.

**Divisions:** All divisions will be required to be mixed in a 6:1 or 5:2 format, offence will decide. That means all teams will be Co-ed and offence will decide if they will play one girl or two girls.

There will be only 2 divisions available upon sign up. The High School division will consist of those ages 12-18. The Novice/Advanced bracket will be pooled together for Fridays pool play

the teams that get seeded in the lowest 4-6 teams after pool play will then be placed into a Novice bracket for play on Saturday and will become eligible to place and medal in that bracket.

Of course if you are 12-18 yrs. old and cannot find a high-school team to play with you are more than eligible and are encouraged to play with a Novice or Advanced team.

**Format:** A Round-Robin format will be played Friday to determine seeds for Saturday. Saturday will be a single or double elimination bracket depending on the number of teams that register. Fridays games will be played to eleven soft cap at 50 min and hard capped at one hour. Saturdays games will be played to 15, soft cap at 1:20 and hard capped at 1:30. Add 2 points at soft cap to the team that is leading score (not to exceed 15 points) When Hard cap sounds, finish the point and the game is over, if the point that was finished results in a tie game play one more point to determine the winner.

**Uniforms:** Each team will be responsible for bringing matching shirts. Please bring one colored and one white. These shirts can be regular t-shirts and you may use the USG issued athlete shirt as your white jersey.

**Note:** No alcohol will be allowed on the fields. Utah Summer games is a family focused event.

Coordinator statement: Our vision for this tournament is that it will be one of the most fun tournaments you ever come to. This tournament by nature is one that helps teams around the state develop their skills and develop their love and passion for the sport of Ultimate. We do have several high-level teams and players that come to our tournament, these teams and players should view this tournament as an opportunity not only to play against other high level teams (because that will happen) but also to help the more novice teams along during Fridays' pool play. This is a tournament where we can all be ambassadors for the sport of ultimate in our area. Bryce, Jeff and I are striving to build high school and youth ultimate in our state and hope this tournament provides a real learning opportunity for all high school teams.

Spirit of the Game will be paramount and good spirit will be awarded accordingly. Unfortunately, we have had cases of very poor sportsmanship and poor spirit shown in the past. It is within the Coordinators jurisdiction to dismiss a player or even a whole team if these extreme cases are observed, these will be handled in a case by case basis. It is upon the Captains of each team to set the Spirit tone for the tournament and be responsible for how your team carries themselves.
